<p>STIPULATED MOTION FOR ENTRY OF ORDER AMENDING PRELIMINARY SETTLEMENT APPROVAL ORDER</p>	

The parties, by their undersigned counsel, jointly move this Court for entry of an Order amending this Court's April 7, 2005 Order Regarding Conditional Settlement Class Certification and Preliminary Settlement Approval (the "Preliminary Settlement Approval Order" as set forth below. In support of this Motion, the parties state:

1. This Court signed the Preliminary Settlement Approval Order on April 7, 2005. The parties request entry of an Order Amending the Preliminary Settlement Approval Order to provide that:

- a. The deadline for class members to mail written objections to the proposed settlement shall be extended from May 6 to May 20, 2005 (so as to afford class members adequate time after receiving the Notice of Proposed Settlement to mail such objections);
- b. The Hearing on Final Approval of the Settlement (the "Hearing") shall be held before this Court on June 22, 2005 at 1 p.m.;
- c. Defendant shall establish and maintain through the date of the Hearing a Settlement Website containing printable copies of the following: 1) Amended Class Action Complaint, 2) Settlement Agreement, 3) Stipulated Motion for Entry of Order Regarding Conditional Settlement, Class Certification and Preliminary Settlement Approval, 4) Parties' Submittal of Affidavits in Support of Motion Seeking Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement, 5) Order Amending Preliminary Settlement Approval, and 6) Notice of Proposed Settlement (so as to provide class members with ready access to these materials); and
- d. The Notice of Proposed Settlement shall be revised to provide that class members may inspect the preceding materials on the Settlement Website.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that the Court enter the Order Amending Preliminary Settlement Approval Order that accompanies this Motion.

ORDER AMENDING PRELIMINARY SETTLEMENT APPROVAL ORDER	

This matter comes before the Court upon the joint motion of Plaintiff and Defendant for an order that would amend this Court’s April 7, 2005 Order Regarding Conditional Settlement Class Certification and Preliminary Settlement Approval (the “Preliminary Settlement Approval Order”) as set forth in the parties’ motion. For good cause shown, the Court hereby amends the Preliminary Settlement Approval Order to provide that:

1. The deadline for class members to mail written objections to the proposed settlement shall be, and hereby is, extended from May 6 to May 20, 2005.
2. The Hearing on Final Approval of the Settlement (the “Hearing”) shall be held before this Court on June 22, 2005 at 1 p.m.
3. Defendant shall establish and maintain through the date of the Hearing a Settlement Website containing printable copies of the following: **1)** Amended Class Action Complaint, **2)** Settlement Agreement, **3)** Stipulated Motion for Entry of Order Regarding Conditional Settlement, Class Certification and Preliminary Settlement Approval, **4)** Parties’ Submittal of Affidavits in Support of Motion Seeking Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement, **5)** Order Amending Preliminary Settlement Approval, and **6)** Notice of Proposed Settlement (so as to provide class members with ready access to these materials); and
4. The Notice of Proposed Settlement shall be revised to provide that putative class members may inspect the preceding materials on the Settlement Website.
